Dear Tigercat Families:

Last week the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) extended waivers that allow children ages 0–18 to receive breakfast and lunch at no cost through the end of **December 2020**. The Washtucna School District will begin offering this to our students and children ages 0-18 within our community on Monday, September 14th.

With these waivers, Washtucna can continue providing healthy, nutritious meals at no cost to **all students, (in-person or remote learning students)**. Washtucna will basically continue using the processes they developed last spring, which resulted in more than 300 weekly meals being served to students who were learning at a distance.

On Thursday, September 10th, we will start taking a breakfast and lunch count for Monday, September 14th. Once again, all students are eligible to receive a free breakfast and lunch daily through **December 31st, 2020**. If your child would like to receive a free breakfast or lunch provided by the school, please contact the school at 509.646.3237.

The USDA waivers extend the Summer Food Service Program through **December 31, 2020** or until funds run out. We will continue our advocacy efforts to get the USDA and Congress to fully fund this program through the entire 2020–21 school year
