RE: Moving to Remote Learning on Inclement Weather Days

During times of inclement weather this school year, a decision may be made by the Superintendent, Principal and Transportation Supervisor of the Washtucna School District to suspend face-to-face learning for the day and go to an on-line learning model for student and staff safety purposes. Teaching staff, at each level, has been instructed to prepare all students for remote learning due to school closure. Issues regarding connectivity and being present during live meetings will be taken into consideration. Classroom teachers will communicate with parents and families how teaching and learning shall proceed during remote learning days. It should be noted that at each level, the inclement weather remote learning model may look a little different.

The Instant Alert System will still be utilized in calling you for all situations involving remote learning due to inclement weather as well as for other special situations. We ask that if you change your phone number or email address, please make sure that the school has this updated information to assure that you don't miss any Instant Alert messages. As always, your patience and flexibility in any uncontrollable circumstance such as inclement weather is very much appreciated.
